

INVITATION TO BID

SOUTH HILLS AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS

Sealed proposals will be received by the South Hills Area Council of Governments (SHACOG), Allegheny County, PA until 11:00 A.M. on April 3, 2024, to be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter for the following project:

SHACOG Joint Municipal O&M CCTV Inspections & Cleaning - Year 14

This project includes the Cleaning (Light and Heavy), Plugging, Blocking, Bypass Pumping, Closed Circuit Televising (CCTV) and NASSCO Certified Inspection of Sanitary and Storm Sewers, as well as Traffic Control and Resident Notification.

All contractors wishing to bid on this project **must** be pre-qualified by SHACOG and the participating municipalities. The required instructions will be included in the project specifications. A bid **will not** be accepted from any bidder that is not pre-qualified.

Copies of the drawings, specifications, instructions to bidders, general conditions, forms of proposals and agreement may be obtained at the SHACOG office, 2600 Old Greentree Road, Carnegie, PA 15106, 412-429-1130. A non-refundable fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for each set of plans will be required. An additional fifteen dollars (\$15.00) will be required for each set of plans if they are to be mailed.

Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided by SHACOG. Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of ten (10%) percent of the bid, made payable to SHACOG. All envelopes containing bid proposals must be clearly marked: "Proposal for SHACOG Joint Municipal O&M CCTV Inspections & Cleaning - Year 14." Proposals should be addressed to Stanley Louis Gorski, Executive Director, SHACOG, 2600 Old Greentree Road, Carnegie, PA 15106.

The proposals must be made to SHACOG, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and shall remain firm for a period of ninety (90) days. No bidder may withdraw his proposal during the ninety (90) day period without forfeiting his bid guarantee.

SHACOG reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, or any part thereof, for any reason, and also reserves the right to waive any informality therein.
