

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed proposals will be received by the South Hills Area Council of Governments (SHACOG), Allegheny County, PA until 11:00 A.M. on Wednesday, April 10, 2019 to be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter for the following project:

SHACOG Joint Municipal O&M CCTV Inspections & Cleaning - Year 9

This project includes the Closed Circuit Televising (CCTV), Inspection and Light Cleaning of approximately 57,600 LF of sanitary, storm and combined sewers and approximately 10,400 LF of Heavy Cleaning in the following municipalities:

Crafton Borough
Heidelberg Borough
Ingram Borough
Jefferson Hills Borough
Mt. Oliver Borough

All contractors wishing to bid on this project **must** be pre-qualified by SHACOG and the participating municipalities. The required instructions will be included in the project specifications. A bid **will not** be accepted from any bidder that is not pre-qualified.

Copies of the drawings, specifications, instructions to bidders, general conditions, forms of proposals and agreement may be obtained at the SHACOG office, 2600 Old Greentree Road, Carnegie, PA 15106, 412-429-1130. A non-refundable fee of \$75.00 for each set of plans will be required. An additional ten (\$10.00) dollars will be required for each set of plans if they are to be mailed.

Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided by SHACOG. Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of ten (10%) percent of the bid, made payable to SHACOG. All envelopes containing bid proposals must be clearly marked: "Proposal for SHACOG Joint Municipal O&M CCTV Inspections & Cleaning - Year 9." Proposals should be addressed to Stanley Louis Gorski, Executive Director, SHACOG, 2600 Old Greentree Road, Carnegie, PA 15106.

The proposals must be made to SHACOG, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and shall remain firm for a period of ninety (90) days. No bidder may withdraw his proposal during the ninety (90) day period without forfeiting his bid guarantee.

SHACOG reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, or any part thereof, for any reason, and also reserves the right to waive any informality therein.
